Dear Parents

This has been a very busy week at Hendon Prep.

On Monday 1 October we celebrated our annual Harvest Festival. The School Choir and children from Pre-Prep sang splendidly their musical pieces to mark this seasonal thanks-giving. As Headmaster, I want to offer an enormous thank-you to all pupils (...and families) who so generously donated gifts collected for our local charity: **Barnet Action for Homeless**. I am especially grateful too, to our Year 8 Prefects who accompanied Mrs Stirling to take our 'offerings' to the homeless charity in Finchley.

On Tuesday, selected Prep pupils attended a workshop at the Arts Depot in Finchley. This wonderful educational opportunity, led by Mr Chapman, is in preparation for a public performance later this term, as part of the Shakespeare Schools Festival.
