From the Headmaster:

Dear Parents,

A very warm welcome back to the start of a new academic term. It is lovely to see the children again, looking so refreshed after their holiday break, and so positively engaged in their learning already!

As the Spring Term begins, I want to offer the good wishes of the School community to all our Y6 and Y8 pupils who are currently undertaking 11+ and 13+ examinations and interviews. We know that our pupils have been preparing hard for the challenges that they are currently facing and we want their individual efforts to be rewarded in due course.

This half-term our theme is: *Tradition*. This theme will be exploring the rich cultural and religious beliefs and customs that exist in our School community and contrasting these against the backdrop of our wider British society. I am hoping that more children will volunteer to offer a short presentation on their interpretation of this theme at our weekly assemblies. Do please try to encourage your child to take-up this challenge, perhaps with a friend. The presentation does not need to be more than 2 mins long and it does not necessarily need to be a power point.
