From the Headmaster:

Dear Parents,

When was the last time you wrote anything creative?

As you will know, this week is Hendon Prep Book Week and as part of this week, every child from Reception to Year 8 has been tasked with a creative writing exercise, what we call 'A Big Write'!

The stimulus for every child's written piece centred around the visit of actors from Image Theatre on Tuesday morning who, with additional cast members from the pupil audience, presented their version of the story of the puppet/boy Pinocchio. The best authors from each age category will be announced at School assembly next week and their individual creative pieces will be shared with other schools via a teacher resource platform called Pobble.

On Wednesday morning this week the whole school began the day with 'buddy reading'. This allowed pupils in senior prep to hook-up with children in the Pre-prep to share their love of reading. This theme has extended into Thursday with children arriving at school dressed in costumes as their favourite book character both to support the charitable project 'Solar Buddies' and to acknowledge World Book Day! Congratulations also to pupils in Year 6 who have participated in live Skype calls to Kingscourt School, Hampshire as part of 'Cognita Calling' on this special day. Our pupils were able to share their

knowledge and enjoyment of reading and their favourite book characters with children of a similar age. Thank-you to Miss Tsepani for supporting this great initiative.
