School Reminders

Arrivals

Please do not arrive prior to 8.15am to drop off students in the morning, unless you are attending Morning Club. Morning Club is from 7.30-8.15am and is chargeable. Drop off for all students is between 8.15-8.30am. Please do not leave children unattended as staff do not begin Duty in the Forecourt or the playground until **8.15am.**

Drive and Drop

Please be reminded that our morning drive and drop is only for students Year 1 and above. This is to ensure flow of traffic is quick and not hindered. Children in Preschool and Reception should be accompanied by a parent/career and dropped off at the EY gate in the mornings.

Centralising of School Processes

We are aware that this year a number of previously school level processes have been changed. Whilst centralising of processes such as billing and upgrades in technology such as Cognita Connect are all part of improving efficiency and making things easier, there can be a period of transition, tweaking and tech glitches which require patience. Your patience with the HPS Office staff is appreciated as they support an increased number of parental queries at the start of this term regarding issues such as booking of After School Clubs, accessing of menus, billing, payments and so on.

Late to School

If your child is in Year 1-6 and arrives at school after 8.30am please can they use the main entrance to come in. If you are in Preschool or Reception (EYFS) please call the school office and a member of the EYFS team will come to collect your child. Please note that our Preschool is part of the school, and morning sessions start at 8.30am.

All parents should now be using the Cognita Connect App to communicate with the school. Please send any message via Cognita Connect as this is the most efficient way to ensure that your messages are directed to the most appropriate member of the HPS team.

Meet the Teacher and Parents' Coffee

Over the next week, parents have the opportunity to meet their new teachers and to get to know each other in a series of coffee mornings. These will start at 8.45am in the school hall and run to about 9.30am. After

dropping your children (8.15-8.30am), if you are attending, we ask that you return to the site at 8.45am. There will be a brief overview of the year with teachers and then an opportunity for parents to mingle over coffee. These meetings are informal, and a chance for parents to reconnect. All parents have received the class timetable, termly curriculum overview and messages which will be delivered at these sessions, so if you can't attend, please do not worry.

Staff Absences

Just a gentle reminder that Hendon Prep staff, just like all employees, can take planned and unplanned leave. Teachers always do their best to avoid time off during term time, but there are occasions when this is not possible. Be assured that classes and lessons will always be covered during these times, which may include religious holidays, illness, family emergencies or professional development days, to name a few. We may sometimes need to a cancel teacher-run after school club due to staff absence, however your child will be offered a free place in supervision if you require, and your understanding of this is always appreciated.

After School Clubs

Following Voice of the Parent feedback we have enhanced our after-school club offering this term to include Clubs that parents had fed back as wanting the school to source, including Dance, more Sports and Investigative Clubs. Please contact the Office as there are still spaces on these external Clubs which your child may be interested in attending. Please note that if we do not get enough students attending these Clubs, we cannot run them, which is disappointing. But again your understanding is appreciated.

Enhancing and Stretching in our Curriculum

Making connections

Year 5 pupils are so excited to be back in school! They took advantage of the beautiful weather and both classes moved Form Time outside onto the roof terrace. The children discussed their aspirations and hobbies, communicating their feelings clearly and with confidence. They then created a 'web of connections' by reflecting on same interests.



Analysing literature

Year 6 have been working collaboratively to dissect challenging classical literary texts. This week, they studied Charles Dicken's Oliver Twist. They discussed archaic language and analysed the authorial technique employed by Dickens to illustrate meaning.
