Headteacher Message

Dear parents, carers and children,

Throughout the week, children have been sharing words of kindness with each other and with me. Our youngest students in Pre-Prep Assembly were beautifully able to explain the link between wearing odd socks and Anti-Bullying week and how we may have differences, but that it is never ok to be unkind to each other. We shared the story 'Kindness is my Superpower' and I know this is a story that our children particularly love.

With just 3 weeks now until the end of term, our school, like all others have Christmas activities and events planned (see final section for details). With events cancelled or virtual last year, there is a real sense of excitement and anticipation as we look forward to these celebrations. Anti-Bullying Week

Enhancing and Stretching our Curriculum

French Foundations

As French is part of our unique EYFS PLUS Curriculum at Hendon Prep, our children start to learn French in the Preschool. Spanish Extensions

We add Spanish to our curriculum in Year 1 and are always impressed with how children embrace learning two languages, along with daily English in school. This week Year 6 have been learning how to use a bilingual dictionary to extend their knowledge in Spanish. They are learning how to express opinions and using various strategies to extend their written sentences. This gives our children a great start to any Senior School they move on to.
