Rain most certainly doesn't stop play (or learning!) at Hendon Prep. This week, pupils from Year 3 and 4 who have chosen Fitness for their Wednesday afternoon Enrichment session took part in a yoga session due to the bad weather outside.

Yoga improves balance, strength, endurance, and aerobic capacity in children. A growing body of research has also shown that yoga can improve focus, memory, self-esteem, academic performance, and classroom behaviour too.



#### **Illuminating experiments**

Year 3 have been learning about Light and Shadows. They made holes in boxes before peering inside to see what they could - or couldn't - see. Which materials and colours showed up the best? And which special materials reflects almost all the light directly back to its source? Do you know?



#### **Expanding Beyond The Classroom**

Year 4 spent an informative afternoon at Hendon United Synagogue this week. Rabbi Zvi Portnoy gave them an exciting tour of the synagogue and the children got to see all the wonderful things that they have been learning about in their R.E lessons.

The visit also included a talk about Jewish tradition and customs, discussion on artefacts, undressing and dressing a Sefer Torah, and an explanation of the recent Jewish festivals. Trips like this are so important to build on the knowledge that pupils have acquired during their lessons and to foster an understanding of how beliefs are put into practice.
